- The museum visit was an enlightening experience, showcasing the historical significance of the Bombay High Court and its contribution to the legal landscape of India.




- The library visit highlighted the importance of continuous learning and research in the legal profession. The students were encouraged to make the most of the extensive legal literature and resources available.
