The duration of faculty exchange visits shall be determined on a case by case basis. Exchange periods can vary from one day to one week, subject to mutual agreement between the parties involved.

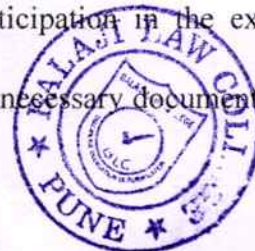
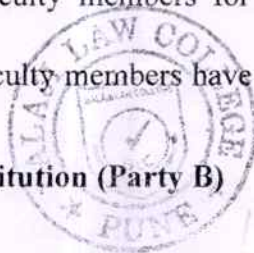
