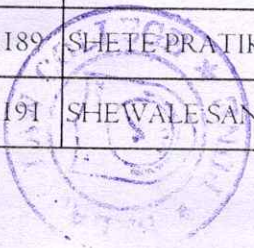

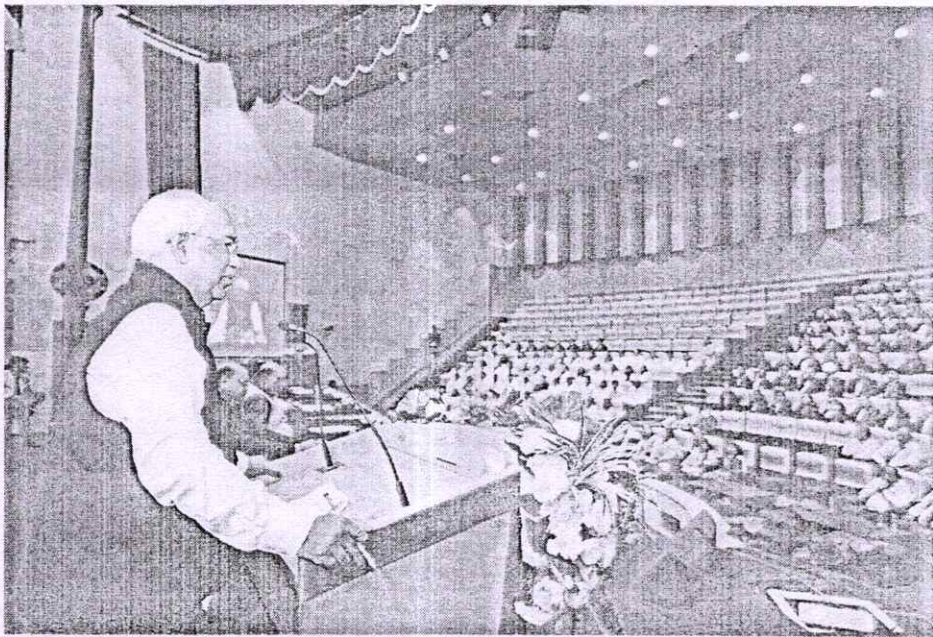
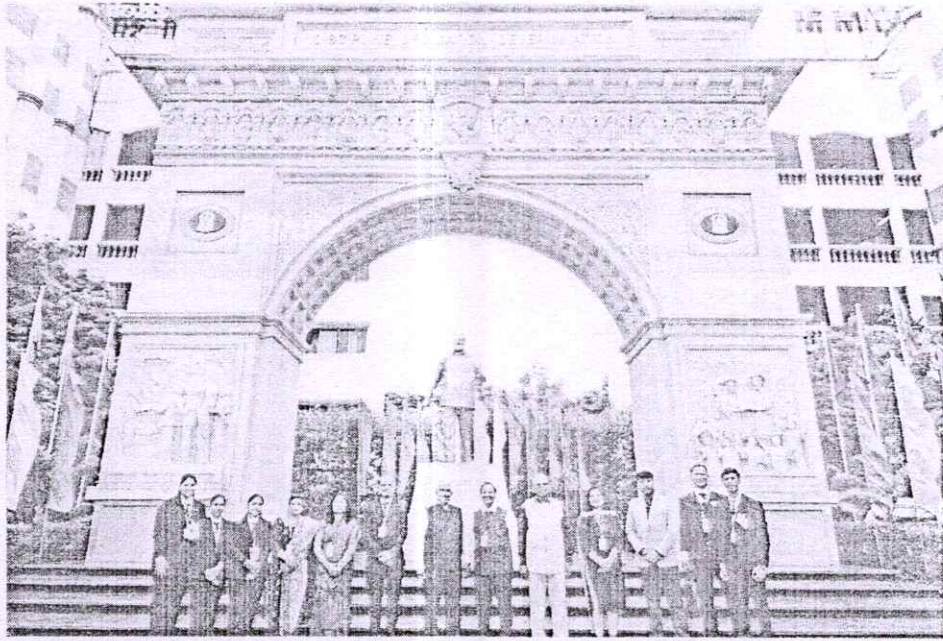

This event is expected to pave the way for more students of Balaji Law College to explore educational opportunities abroad, thus expanding their horizons and enhancing their academic and professional journeys.

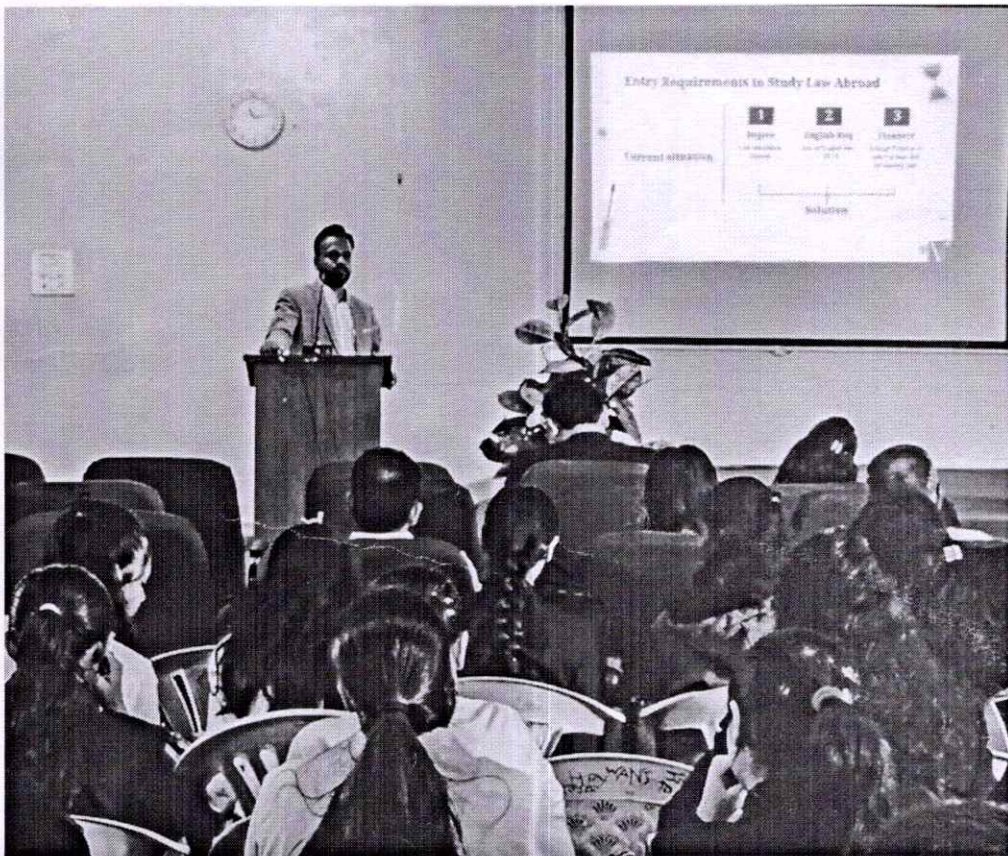
